When should I get a test for COVID-19 (coronavirus)?

If you have any of the mild symptoms, as indicated on this flyer, take a free COVID-19 test.

How can I make an appointment?

Call 0800 1202 to make an appointment for a COVID-19 test. Make sure you have your BSN number (Burgerservicenummer) ready when calling. It is also possible to get a test without a BSN number.

When do I contact my doctor?

If you have a fever (above 38 degrees Celsius), pain, pressure in the chest or if you have trouble breathing. Call your doctor, do not visit!

How much does the COVID-19 test cost?

The test is free.

Is the COVID-19 test anonymous?

No, but we only use your phone number to inform you about the test result. You will not receive a letter about your test result. We do not give out your details or test result to another institution like the police or IND.

What should I do after taking a test?

Go home immediately. Keep your distance from other people. You will receive the test result within 48 hours.

I have a positive test result, what to do now?

A positive result means that you are infected with COVID-19 and that you could infect other people. You must stay at home. Civic Healthcare (GGD Amsterdam) will contact you to inform you about the next steps.

Can I have physical contact with my family members if I have a positive test result?

No, keep distance from your family and friends. Follow the instructions of Civic Healthcare (GGD) to stay safe and to stay informed about the recovery period.

Can I go to church, the market or work, if I have a positive test result?

No, you must stay at home. Protect yourself and the community. After your recovery period you can go outside.

Why do I have to follow the measures if I do not have any symptoms?

Not everyone develops symptoms when infected by COVID-19. This means that no one knows for sure if they are infected.
